We thought that having churches on every street corner surely meant that most people were Christians. We quickly realized that many of the churches were not full. Many had plateaued at some time or were in decline. The second thing we discovered was that many Christians did not consider the US to be a mission field nor did they consider themselves missionaries. When we asked people about the church's missionaries, they always spoke about people who lived in other countries.

As we have worked with churches and believers throughout the US, Latin America, and Africa for the last 30+ years, our heart has become increasingly burdened to help lead Christians to see our God as a Glocal Missionary God, our neighborhoods near and far as Glocal Mission Fields, and every believer as Glocal Missionaries.

The results of missional complacency in our backyards are devastating. In most of the US, less than 25% attend church on a weekly basis. In many of our nation's larger cities, less than 10% attend church. The good news is that these trends are not irreversible. Our God will never stop seeking the lost! The Holy Spirit is stirring many churches and many believers to awaken, rise up and embrace the challenge of reaching **ONE MORE**.

Glocal Mission values collaboration and team work! The Great Commission is too big for anyone to accomplish alone and too important not to try to do it together. Our History



FROM S. KOREA TO ECUADOR

Dr. David Kim, born in South Korea, moved to Ecuador in 1989 to serve as a missionary and church planter for 12 years. The experiences of being a bi-vocational church planter and becoming fluent in Spanish are skills that God uses to help David train and lead church planters all over the world today. Also, during this time in Ecuador, David and Juhee were married!



LAUNCH OF GLOCAL MISSION

In October 2016, Glocal Mission was launched with the backing of the Texas District of the LCMS. We began with 5 churches in Houston and a mandate from God to seek the lost, disciple the found, and multiply disciple makers and churches cross-culturally and globally.



CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY IRVINE

In 2002, David and Juhee moved to Southern California to pursue a Master's Degree in Divinity. This was the Kim's first time living in the US and was an invaluable time of learning theology, the English language, and the culture of the American church.



INTERNATIONAL EXPANSION

Glocal Mission expands to many other States in the US, to Central and South America, and to Africa. Dr. Kim accepted invitations to speak and encourage the body of Christ to intentionally engage in mission. This resulted initially in ministry coaching, training, and, subsequently, the planting of many churches.



HOUSTON, TEXAS

The Kims moved to Houston where David became Mission Director for Linc Houston. During these nine years of ministry, in America's most diverse city, God put the idea of Glocal Mission in David's heart. Leading the church to see our global and local mission is essential to us obeying the Great Commission.



MULTIPLICATION

Starting only with 3 key mission leaders, there are now more than 50,000 people impacted by the actions of love and the message of hope and restoration in Jesus across nations and people groups.

5 MARKS OF A GLOCAL MISSION CHRISTIAN

MULTIPLY DISCIPLE MAKERS

We prioritize our time, energy, and resources into making disciples that make disciples. We measure the true effectiveness of ministry by the development and multiplication of disciple makers. Matthew 28:18-20, 2 Timothy 2:2

SERVE GLOCALLY

We believe God's missionary heart is borderless and that the biblical model of ministry is for each believer and ministry to intentionally seek the lost and disciple the found, locally (in their Jerusalem) and globally (their Judea, Samaria and uttermost parts of the world).

DISCIPLE LIKE JESUS

All believers are called to be a disciple and to make disciples. Biblical discipleship is Relational, Holistic and Transformational: Discipleship must be highly relational in nature and is most effective in groups of 3 - 12 people. Discipleship must include Head (theology), Heart (mission), Hands (skills), and Habits (lifestyle). Discipleship must be transformational and lead to life change.

BALANCE DISCIPLESHIP AND EVANGELISM

The Great Commission requires an equal commitment to Evangelism and Discipleship. Because Scripture puts equal emphasis on both Evangelism and Discipleship, our ministries must excel in both areas.

SEEK COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION

We will seek the Lordship of Jesus in our communities by pursuing the Three Missional Outcomes: Good – Make a difference; Better – Make relationships; and Best – Make disciples.

SEEK THE LOST

All believers are called to be salt and light where we work, study, live, and play. God has uniquely gifted each of us and placed us where we are to share the love of Jesus with those around us.

COMPASSIONATELY

Jesus demonstrated the compassion of God everywhere he went and has put his love in our hearts to do the same.
Matt. 9:36 , Rom. 5:5

INTENTIONALLY

Jesus came to SEEK the lost and we must intentionally allow him to do the same through us today. Our prayers, actions, and relationships must be intentional. Luke 19:10

URGENTLY

Today is the day of salvation and the people in our lives need the Gospel NOW! Jesus said the harvest is plentiful AND the fields are ripe. He is moving all around us and invites us to join him. 2 Cor. 6:2, Matt. 9:37, John 4:35

DISCIPLE THE FOUND

RELATIONAL

HOLISTIC

MULTIPLY DISCIPLE MAKERS & CHURCHES

By definition, a disciple of Jesus is one who is first a disciple, and secondly, one who makes other disciples. Our world today needs the type of Gospel growth that we see in the Book of Acts. The first church, by the power of the Holy Spirit changed the world - and they did it through the addition of converts and the multiplication of disciple makers and churches.

ADDITION OF CONVERTS - ACTS 5:14

"Believers were added to the Lord."

What an incredible statement in Scripture. On a regular basis, lives were changed and their eternal destiny was altered as the first church proclaimed the good news of the Risen Jesus!

MULTIPLICATION OF DISCIPLES - ACTS 6:1

"The number of the disciples was multiplied."

The first church began to see exponential growth and outreach when the disciples began to disciple others who discipled others. This is Biblical multiplication!

MULTIPLICATION OF CHURCHES - ACTS 9:31

"The Church... multiplied"

Churches planting churches that plant churches is God's strategy for His Kingdom to penetrate every nook and cranny of society.

**“What you have heard from me...
entrust to faithful men who will be able to
teach others also.”** 2 Tim. 2:1-2

THE POWER OF MULTIPLICATION

BE ONE. MAKE ONE. REACH ONE. God does supernatural work through normal people!

Multiplication is simply when one person discipled another who discipled another who discipled another, etc. Multiplication movements seldom happen if the church only relies on the “professionals” to do gospel events. Jesus would have a dynamic partnership between apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, teachers, and ALL believers to work together under Christ so that every believer is empowered to make disciples. Eph. 4:11-13

God has called each of us to be a disciple and to make disciples. We are always learning from someone and investing in others. Will you join the Glocal Mission Challenge to be a disciple and to make disciples?

God can use one person to reach thousands.

If you disciple two persons per year, and then each of those disciples will disciple two more each year, the impact will be great!

Year 5 - 32 people
Year 10 - 1,024 people

Year 33 - 8,589,934,592 people
